

Changes in the press' opinions about reading festival (haydn.peachey)

1971 article

- .calls the 17.000£ fines the “price for peace
- .pubs barricade doors to keep pop fans out
- . the press says 50,000 pop fans “descend” on reading (negative wording)
- .pubs ban fans (sub heading)

2019 article

- . refers to acts as “incredible acts”
- .calls festival as an “extravaganza!”
- .says the event has a “whopping” eight stages

The opinion of the press in 1971 and 2019 are very different an example of this is how the 1971 press says that the 17.000£ fines were “the price for pop piece” whereas the 2019 press says that the festival is incredible and how it is an “extravaganza!” or how the 1971 press explains how the pubs of reading had to barricade their doors to stop fans getting in.
