



Discovering Daily Lives

Lots of different people lived on the Oxford Road with very different lives!

If we look at one person on the Oxford Road, for example John Stephens, a corn miller who was aged 54 in 1911. What sort of things might he have done? What would be important to him? Do you think he bought milk from the local dairy, or went to the local pub? Maybe he needed to repair furniture or fix his bike?

Thinking about things like this can help build a picture (or a story) of what a person's life was like!

We want you to choose a person from the census records in this resource to create a story.

Maybe there is a hole in the roof and they need to get it fixed with slate, or they're seeing a family member off at the train station, or they need to get a new shirt because they burned one whilst ironing it!

Use the business directories to discover where your character might have shopped, worked or even got repairs in their daily lives!



Activity 1: Build a character part 1

Choose a person from one of the census sheets and answer the following questions:

- Where do they live?
- How many people lived with them?
- What jobs did they have?
- What age are they?
- Did they have any lodgers?
- Why do you think they might have had lodgers?

Activity 3: Building a Story

You have found lots of information about individuals on the Oxford Road and different shops and businesses that those individuals may have used or even worked at! Now you can begin to tell a story about your Character.

Here are some questions to help you start:

- How will their day start?
- Do they have a problem?
- How can they solve it?
- Who can help them solve their problem?
- Where do they need to go?
- How did the problem get solved (did it get solved at all)?
- What does the end of their day look like?



Census Records, Directories and Registers

In this resource you will find a selection of census records from 1891 and 1911. Census records were taken every 10 years and so fall in years like 1911, 1921, etc.

There are also extracts business directories from 1887, 1899 and 1914.

Try to match the businesses you use with your character to the year your character appears in a census.

It is possible that the businesses in 1914 were around in 1911 and were therefore used by the people in the 1911 census. We don't have directories that completely match up to the census years but we can make some educated guesses about people and businesses in the Oxford Road in the 1911 - 1914 time-frame. The same goes for the 1887 and 1899 directories with the 1981 census.


